Rules of Engagement:

Submit a technical paper (no more than 20 pages) by midnight on April 15, 2022, to be considered. Please email the paper to info@itsva.org with “Student Paper Competition” on the subject line.

It is acceptable for papers to have been previously submitted to other conferences or journals, although extra consideration will be given to original work. Regardless, the paper must have been written in the last year. The student submitting the paper must be either the sole or first author.

Papers shall follow TRB formatting guidelines.
